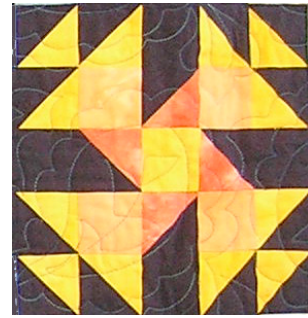

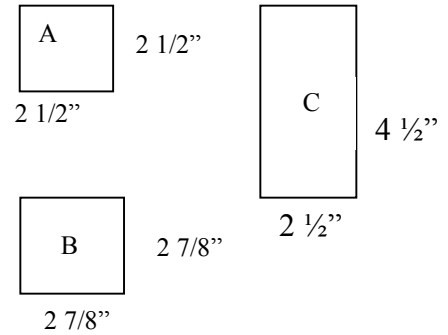
Block of the Month #8

Finished Size: 10"

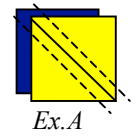


Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
Yellow	9 X 10"	1(A) 6(B)
Orange	6 X 6"	4(A)
Red Orange	6 X 6"	4(A)
Navy	8 X 12"	6(B) 4(C)

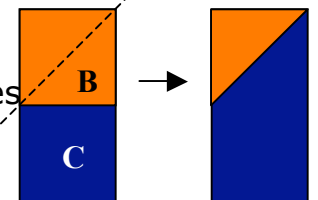


Sewing Directions

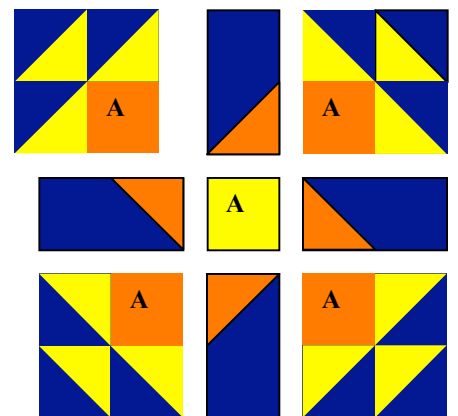
1. Make half square triangles by pairing the six yellow (B) squares with the six navy (B) squares. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. (*Ex. A*). Cut on the drawn line and press toward the navy fabric. This should result in a total of twelve half square triangles.



2. Place an red orange (A) square on a (C) rectangle right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown. Stitch on the drawn line. Flip to right side and press. Trim excess if desired. Make a total four.



3. Using the yellow and orange (A) squares, the half square triangles units created in step one, and the units created in step three, lay out the block according to block assembly diagram. Sew into sections, then sew the sections into rows.
